2. Tap this key to make your brush bigger.
5. Hold down this key to make a perfect circular selection or perfect square selection. We have said this key is a "constrain" key in photoshop.

Across

7. By holding down this key while working with selections, you can take away from an existing selection.
9. Holding down this key will automatically enable you to scroll around your image with your mouse.
10. Shortcut is A, and this "flavor" of the tool allows the user to decide which pixels to select.
11. Use this tool to draw a circular selection which you could then dump paint in to for round shapes. Shortcut is the letter M.
14. Use this tool to magnify your image for a more detailed edit.
15. This keyboard combination will deselect everything.
16. Shortcut is B. Used to paint.

Down

1. This tool can be used to remove blemishes in an image. Shortcut is J.
3. This tool is used to make selections on "auto pilot", whereby the computer guesses what you want selected based on color and texture. Shortcut is A.

Down

4. This tool is used to dump paint in an area.
6. This word refers to when you are using the magic eraser. You can adjust this number lower to remove less or higher to remove more.
8. Tap this key to make your brush smaller.
12. Shortcut for this tool is V.
13. This tool is used to erase things manually. Shortcut is E.
